Main Duties:

- Conducting emergency calls, clerking surgical patients, admitting and investigating them in consultation with the surgeons on call or senior residents in the hospital, for guidance and supervision.
- Attending lectures, training seminars, conducting or participating in ward rounds.
- Rotating in different institutions/ stations, as determined by the training programme management to attain requisite skills.
- Offering surgical care including participating in surgical out-patient or consultation clinics,
- Participating in surgical operations, reviewing patients, and following them, under their seniors' supervision and instructions.
